

CGTBB Regular Meeting—November 9, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Tim Cummins.

Financial Update:

- Some minor expenses for Cavalcade and ISSMA regional contests have not been paid yet. Ending balance as of October 31, 2010 was 123,025.01.
- The board opened the Uniform Fund with money earned from the two contests this year. The fund has \$20,000 and is a secure account. The band will need \$70,000 for new uniforms.
- Both State and Federal taxes are complete and will be mailed out tomorrow.

Upcoming events:

- BOA Grand Nationals is begins this Thursday. Pictures will be taken after the performance. The band will not know Saturday's performance time until after awards on Friday night approximately 10pm.
- Fall Banquet is Thursday, November 18th at 6:30pm. Please send in your payment.

- Percussion concert will be held on Tuesday, December 14th at U-Indy's Christel DeHaan Center.

General Information:

The new guard will not have as many contests, all contests will be in-state, and will not attend WGI contests. This guard is excellent for those guard members who cannot commit the time involved with the World Class Winter Guard (new name for current winter guard program).
